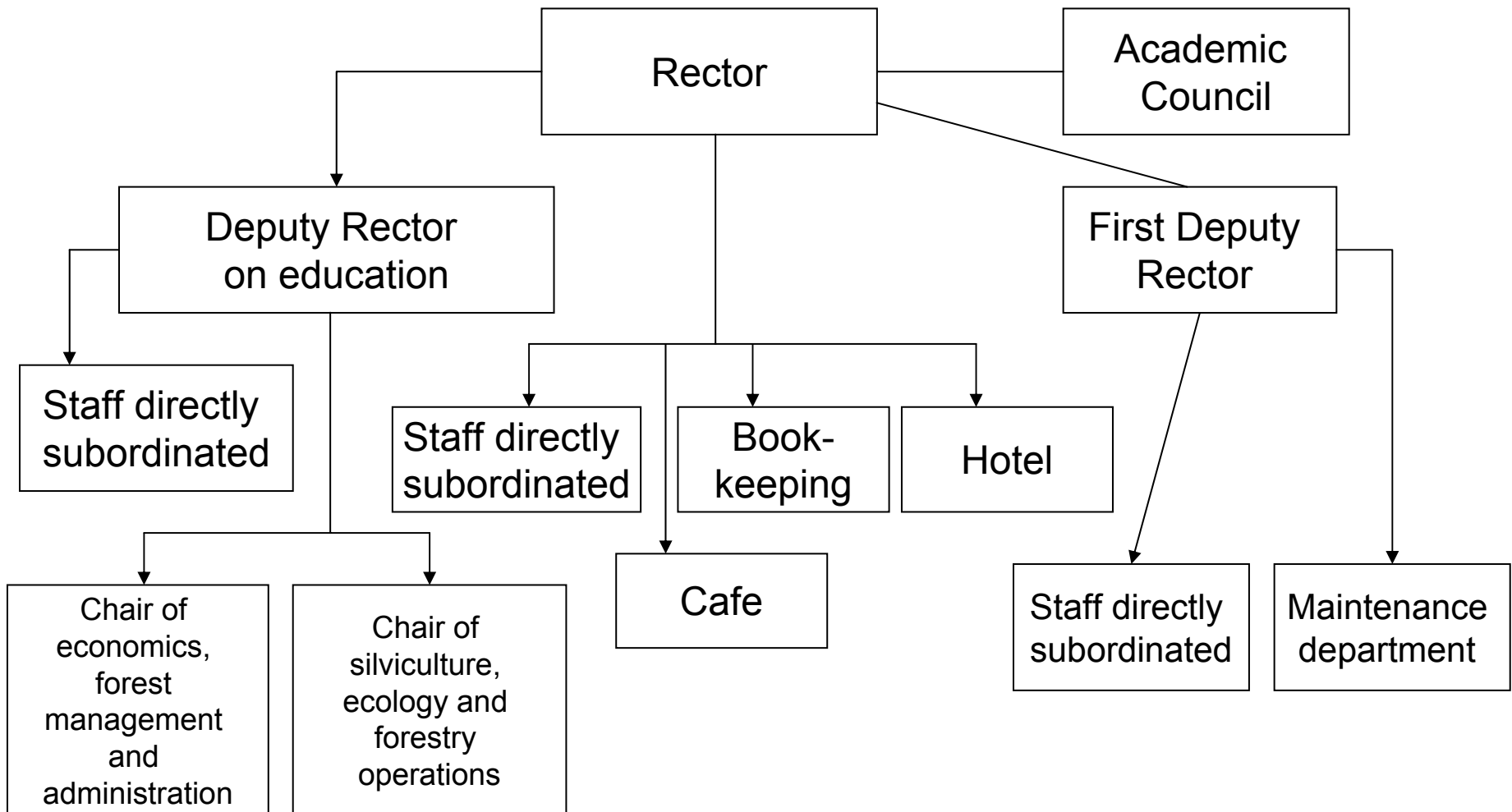

The Institute:

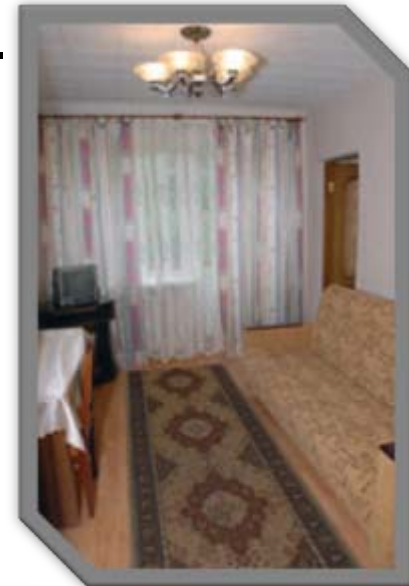
- ✓ develops the concept of secondary vocational education in accordance with the demands of forest and education laws,
